

## Important Information from the Goodman Metro District Regarding Improvements to District Owned Parks & Open Space

Dear Owner:

In an effort to leverage the Goodman Metropolitan District's resources with those of other agencies to provide further improvements to Central Park, Creekside Park, and Highridge Park, the District engaged the landscape architect firm Architerra to prepare conceptual master plans for each of the parks. The initial, concept master plans were presented at an open house on January 7, 2014, and revised concept plans were presented on January 28, 2014.

The District would like to thank all of you who attended one of the open houses or provided comments and input on the conceptual plans. Based in part on this feedback, the District has determined to submit a grant application for Creekside Park for this grant cycle, and to hold-off on submitting an application for Central Park until the Central Park plan is further refined to take into account the various comments and concerns expressed by property owners and residents of the District.

This will not only allow the District to focus its resources on completing phase 1 of the Creekside Park master plan (if the grant is awarded to the District), but also time to revise and solicit additional feedback on the Central Park plan.

Again, the District truly appreciates your comments and constructive criticism, and looks forward to an ongoing dialogue with the community on providing enhancements and additional amenities to the parks, trails, and open space within The Farm community.
