Community Update – Start of Central Park Phase II Playground Construction

The Central Park Phase II Playground construction is anticipated to begin on Monday, May 4th. The first phase of the project included the replacement of the equipment in the large play pit. This next phase of the renovation will include enlarging the play pit where the teeter-totters are currently located to make space for a new climbing feature, adding swings, replacing the small retaining wall separating the larger play area from the pavilion with a seat wall, and replacing the stairway handrails.

Construction is anticipated to start Monday, May 4, but you may notice some staking, fencing, and other preliminary work before Monday.

We are excited for this next phase of the project, and hope the community will have a chance to safely use the playground again soon.

An illustration of the new climbing feature and some of the other improvements to the park can be found below. Please note the shade structures will be added during the next phase of the project, and will not be installed at this time.
