COMMUNITY UPDATE

Dear Community Residents,

As we head towards the end of 2022, our District Board of Directors desires to provide our residents with a community update on what your Board has been working on and has accomplished over the past 12 months. To begin, back in July 2021, a community survey was conducted asking general questions about resident use at the three main parks; Central, Creekside and Highridge. The survey also included specific questions about the need or desire to add additional improvements to these three parks and was a great tool for our Board of Directors to view our open space parks in the eyes of our community residents.

In part, based upon the input from our survey, the following area of improvements have been completed over the past twelve (12) months;

- ***Highridge Park Landscape and Play Equipment Capital Improvements Project Completed***
- ***The Arapahoe Road Xeric and Improvement Project Commenced in May of 2022 and will be finalized in the Spring of 2023***
- ***Central Park Tennis Courts were fully resurfaced and a between court fence added***
- ***Central Park Pickleball temporary nets purchased for Tennis Court B***
- ***Central Park Pickleball reservation system updated***
- ***Umbrellas added to the various picnic tables in Central Park***
- ***Shrub and Landscape Beds at both Central and Creekside Parks have been improved/updated***
- ***Additional trees have been added to all three parks this Fall***
- ***An updated Surveillance Camera System has been ordered and pending installation this Fall for both Central and Creekside Parks***
- ***Baseball back stop wood was replaced this past summer***

And we are continuing to look at new projects in 2023 that are still in the discussion phase, including, but not necessarily limited to;

- ***Improvements to the baseball field, including improved dugouts, and additional seating***
- ***Additional Lighting considerations for all three parks***
- ***Adding a new shelter and seating area at both Central and Creekside Parks***
- ***Replacement of the Tennis Court Windscreens***
- ***Additional tree planting in all three parks***
